

Research Integrity & Reporting Guide

How to raise concerns safely and responsibly (non-retaliation).

- What to report: plagiarism, fabrication/falsification, unethical recruitment, consent issues, privacy breaches, authorship disputes, and undisclosed conflicts of interest.
- How to report: confidential channels and optional anonymous submission; provide factual detail and supporting evidence where available.
- What happens next: triage within 5 business days, preliminary assessment, formal review (if needed), and corrective actions.
- Protections: non-retaliation commitment, confidentiality safeguards, and fair process for all parties.
