

CoU Researcher Well-Being Index (RWBI) — Methods Note

How RWBI is calculated and used (non-medical, research-workflow focus).

- RWBI is a composite score (0–100) based on five domains: workload balance, supervision quality, support access, psy
- Each domain is scored 0–20 and averaged; institution-level scores are aggregated from anonymized submissions.
- RWBI is used for planning services, improving supervision practices, and reporting research capacity health.
- RWBI is not a medical assessment and does not diagnose conditions.
